

# **FOCUS AREA 1: STUDENT LEARNING**

## How are you currently assessing your progress in this area?

Achievement

Enterprise Elementary is using Acadience and Rise data to assess growth and progress. 2022 Rise scores indicate that Enterprise Elementary has improved in the all three areas of Language Arts, Math, and Science. From 2018 to 2022 Language Arts proficiency increased 8.4% with 71.7% of the students showing growth. Math proficiency has increased 9.3% with 70.1% of the students showing growth. Science proficiency has increase 7% with 65.6% of students showing growth. The bottom 25% of student's growth percentage increased from 68.7% to 83.7% between 2018-2022

Students identified as economically disadvantaged	52%	Enterprise Elementary will continue to fund the WIN program as a tier 2 intervention program to provide students the reading instruction and skills needed. Progress monitoring data will be used to identify areas of need.
Students with disabilities	10%	Students with disabilities/IEP's will be provided Special Ed instruction, WIN tier 2 instruction, and accommodations in tier 1 instruction with in the classroom.
Students identified as English learners	>1%	Win time and ESL small group services will be provided for Language Arts needs.
Students in major racial and ethnic groups	9%	Enterprise Elementary will continue to fund the WIN program along with the 95% reading materials as a tier 2 intervention program to provide students the reading instruction and skills needed. Progress monitoring data will be used to identify areas of need.

Enterprise Elementary has been focusing on classroom engagement and math tasks strategies to improve tier 1 instruction. Money has been allocated for teachers to purchase items that enhance classroom engagement.
